Eligible Entrants (you, your)	Entry to the Promotion is open to New Zealand residents 18 years of age or over in all Eligible States/Territories who fulfil the method of entry requirements set out in this Schedule. Employees (and their immediate families) of the Promoter are ineligible to enter.
Details of prizes	One winner will receive a passenger ride experience for them and a mate (2 x rides total) with professional rally driver Hayden Paddon at the North Island Rally (Auckland) on Tuesday 6 October 2026 . The ride will take place in a controlled rally environment as part of the North Island Rally (Auckland) event located at 399 Whitford Park Rd, Brookby 2576. The experience is not transferable, exchangeable or redeemable for cash.
Travel & Expenses	Winners are solely responsible for arranging and covering the costs of: • Travel to and from the North Island Rally (Auckland) event • All transport, transfers, meals, insurance, and accommodation The Promoter will not be liable for any costs incurred by the winner outside of the rally ride experience.
Total number of prizes	One prize comprising a passenger ride experience for the winner and a mate (2 x rides total).

Draw Details	A winner will be drawn at 10am AEST / 12pm NZST on Friday 18 September 2026 via the contact details provided during entry.

Notification of winners	The winner will be contacted immediately after the prize draw on Friday 18 September 2026 via the contact details provided during entry.

The Promoter and its affiliates and partners accept no responsibility or liability for any injury, loss, or damage incurred as a result of participation in the prize activity. General	By entering the Promotion, participants agree to the terms of this Schedule and to the Competition Terms and Conditions, below. Any personal information provided by you will be collected and handled in accordance with the Promoter's Privacy Policy and Collection Statement available at Privacy Statement NZ .

Competition Terms & Conditions

1. Information on how to enter and prize details form part of these terms & conditions (**Terms of entry**). The Terms must be read in conjunction with the Schedule. The Schedule defines the terminology used in these Terms of entry. Where there is any inconsistency between these Terms and the Schedule, the Schedule prevails. **Participation in this Promotion is deemed acceptance of these Terms of entry.**
2. Entry is open only to Eligible Entrants of the Eligible States/Territories who satisfy the Method of entry. Directors, officers, management, employees, suppliers (including prize suppliers) and contractors (and the immediate families of directors, officers, management, employees, suppliers and contractors) of the Promoter and of its related bodies corporate, and of the agencies and companies associated with this Promotion are ineligible to enter. 3. The Promotion will be conducted during the Promotion period.
4. The Prize/s are specified in the Details of prizes section of the Schedule.
5. The total prize pool is specified in the Total prize value section of the Schedule.
6. Any prize is valued in Australian dollars unless expressly stated to the contrary.

10. Entrants may submit up to the Maximum number of entries (if applicable).
11. The Promoter accepts no responsibility for any late, lost, delayed, incomplete, incorrectly submitted, corrupted, illegible or misdirected entries, claims or correspondence whether due to omission, error, alteration, tampering, deletion, theft, destruction, disruption to any communication network or medium, or otherwise including those entries not received by the Promoter for any reason. The Promoter is not liable for any consequences of user error including (without limitation) costs incurred. No correspondence will be entered into.
12. The prize(s) will be awarded to the valid entrant(s) drawn randomly in accordance with the Prize draw section of the Schedule. The Promoter may draw additional reserve entries (and record them in order). In the event of an invalid entry or an ineligible entrant, or if the entrant is ineligible to accept the prize, the prize will be awarded to the first reserve entry drawn. To the extent permitted by law, failure by the entrant to provide such proof of identification, authorisation or release will immediately invalidate a prize winner's entitlement to a prize. 16. The Promoter takes no responsibility where it is unable to contact prize winners who have not provided correct or complete contact details. If despite the foregoing clauses, the Promoter incurs a liability to an entrant under any law which implies a Warranty into these Terms of entry which cannot legally be excluded, the Promoter's liability in respect of the Promotion is limited, in the Promoter's discretion, to either resupplying such goods or services as form part of the Promotion or paying the cost of resupplying those goods or services.
22. Without limiting any of the foregoing, in no circumstances will an entrant or the Promoter have any liability to the other for any loss or damage suffered which is indirect or consequential in nature, including without limitation any loss of profit, loss of reputation, loss of goodwill, or loss of business opportunity.
23. The Promoter and its associated agencies and companies will not be liable for any damage in transit to or delay in transit of prizes. The Promoter and its associated agencies and companies makes no representations or warranties as to the timeliness or successful delivery of the prize to the winner(s).
24. The Promoter may in its absolute discretion not accept a particular entry, may disqualify an entry, or cancel the entire Promotion at any time without giving reasons and without liability to any entrants. Verification is at the discretion of the Promoter, whose decision is final. Failure by the Promoter to enforce any of its rights at any stage does not constitute a waiver of those rights.
25. The Promoter has the right to withhold the provision of a prize where the Promoter is aware or reasonably suspects that the provision of the prize would, or may be, in breach of any conduct or compliance policy of the Promoter, its related bodies corporate, or any third party (including the Promoter's customers) or any applicable laws. If the Promoter suspects fraud or misconduct, the prize may be withheld or withdrawn in the Promoter's sole discretion.
26. Prizes, or any unused portion of a prize, are not transferable or exchangeable and cannot be taken as cash, subject to any written directions from a regulatory authority, and must be taken as awarded. Where a prize is unavailable for any reason, the Promoter may substitute the prize for another item of equal or higher value. The Promoter accepts no responsibility for any variation in prize value (including between advertising of the Promotion and receipt of the prize).
27. In the case of the intervention of any outside act, agent or event which prevents or significantly hinders the Promoter's ability (or that of a third party involved with the Promotion) to proceed with the Promotion on the dates and in the manner described in these Terms of entry, including but not limited to vandalism, natural disasters, pandemic or epidemic disease, civil unrest, strike, war, act of terrorism, the Promoter's obligations in respect of the Promotion will be suspended for the duration of the event and, in addition, the Promoter may in its absolute discretion cancel the Promotion and recommence it from the start on the same conditions, subject to approval of the relevant authorities.
28. All entries become the property of the Promoter. As a condition of entering into this Promotion, entrants agree to assign all their rights in and to their entry and any related content to the Promoter, including any copyright or other intellectual property rights in the entry and related content. Without limiting this, the Promoter may use entry content for any and all purposes including commercial purposes. You warrant that entry content is original, lawful and not misleading and that the Promoter's use of such content will not infringe the rights of any third parties. The Promoter has no obligation to credit you as the author of any content submitted and may otherwise do any acts or omissions which would otherwise constitute an infringement of any moral rights you may have as an author of content.
29. The Promotion and these Terms of entry will be governed by the law of the State or Territory in which the Promoter ordinarily resides. Entrants accept the non-exclusive jurisdiction of courts and tribunals of that State or Territory in connection with disputes concerning the Promotion.
